While touring in the History Rock area, I spotted a couple of recent slides on the NW shoulder of Mt. Blackmore. From a distance, these look like dry-loose slides on the recent snow interface around 8,500ft. on a N-NE aspect.

Otherwise, 12-20cm of new snow was present in the area (~ HS 80-115cm), with evidence of wind loading on east aspects, and scouring on west aspects. No other signs of instability were observed.
